New Zealand Black Caps

Last week before the first test with Sri Lanka some of the New Zealand cricketers tested themselves on some of the new one minute challenges. For Challenge 1, level 3 from 2 metres on the insane side with a cricket ball, a new world record was set by Brendon McCullum. His score was 59 with not one dropped catch. Can you beat that? (refer web site for One Minute Challenge details). Our UK distributor reckons that some guys in a first eleven team may have registered a score of 63 – can you believe that?

The challenges reinforced how valuable the Crazy Catch is for visual and reflex skill training for batting, fielding and keeping. Challenge 7 was particularly useful for this with the development of early ball flight path detection. Brendon McCullum had a very intense workout on this. It highlighted the benefit of Crazy Catch with being able to get a lot of repetition in a short space of time compared with many other training options.

Australia / England – The Ashes

How appropriate is the term 'Catches win Matches'. First England win the Ashes after both Warne and Hayden drop Pieterseon early in his innings in the last Ashes test in the UK.
